# US push to pressure Iran rebuffed at nuclear meet

THE US CALLED for a special meeting of atomic inspectors to ramp up pressure against Iran after it violated restrictions set by the landmark nuclear accord. What it got is pushback from Russia, China and Europe, who blame the Trump administration for a crisis that threatens to escalate into war.

The International Atomic Energy Agency's 35-member board of governors gathered on Wednesday at 2:30 pm in Vienna. American diplomats asked for the session after IAEA monitors confirmed Iran had exceeded enriched-uranium limits set under its 2015 deal with world powers.

"Iran's current nuclear posture is clearly aimed at escalating tensions rather than defusing them, and underscores the serious challenges Iran continues to pose to international peace and security," US ambassador to the IAEA Jackie Wolcott told the meeting.

While the State Department sought to marshal support for its 'maximum pressure' campaign against Iran,

other diplomats criticised President Donald Trump for withdrawing from the accord a year ago and reimposing sanctions on vast swathes of the oil exporter's economy.

With accusations flying, the get-together exposed the growing international discord over how to contain a diplomatic crisis that has disrupted shipping and threatened to escalate into a new war in the world's largest oil-producing region.

"IAEA reported that new level of enrichment in Iran increased to 4.5%," tweeted Russia's IAEA ambassador Mikhail Ulyanov before the meeting. "This is low enriched uranium that has nothing to do with nuclear weapons. Any member of IAEA may stockpile it without limits. Being under strict international control it constitutes no proliferation risk."

France, Germany and the UK issued a joint statement on the eve of the meeting saying that while they were concerned by Iran's violations, it's the job of the remaining participants in the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action, as the nuclear accord is known, to mediate disputes.



The EU hammered home that message on Wednesday, saying it was also keen to facilitate trade with Iran.

"The EU deeply regrets the US withdrawal and calls on all countries to refrain from taking any actions that impede the implementation of the JCPOA commitments," it said.

The IAEA meeting takes place as French President Emmanuel Macron's top diplomatic adviser visits Iran for discussions, seeking to persuade the Islamic Republic to reverse course.

Emmanuel Bonne met foreign minister Mohammad Javad Zariif and Ali Shamkhani, secretary of Iran's Supreme National Security Council. Shamkhani said Iran would continue with its policy of gradually abandoning some of



## Iran 'secretly' enriched uranium despite deal: Trump

PRESIDENT DONALD Trump accused Iran of 'secretly' enriching uranium in violation of the 2015 nuclear deal he withdrew from last year, and said the US would soon impose more sanctions on the Islamic Republic.

Trump didn't elaborate on how he knew Iran had violated the nuclear pact or

its nuclear commitments until its 'rights' were upheld. Iran says European partners should ensure it's able to enjoy the economic benefits promised by the deal despite US penalties.

French officials say they see room for compromise as Iran's infringements have been carefully calibrated and Trump has underlined his desire for new talks. Iran's dialogue with Europe never stopped but it said it won't speak to the US unless sanctions are eased first.

Tehran's contraventions have increased pressure on European nations who've urged Iran to stick with the deal even as they struggle to find a mechanism that would allow it to keep selling its oil. They've come up with a trade vehicle called Instex that would pro-

tect some trade with Iran from US penalties but would initially be limited to food and drugs.

Iran is producing oil at the slowest clip since 1986, making US sanctions as effective as the devastating Iraq-Iran war that ended more than 30 years ago. The measures have hit the currency, fuelled inflation and hobbled growth.

US officials say the squeeze is meant to push Iran to negotiate a broader deal that also limits its missile program and support for proxy militias in

what new sanctions he would impose. The International Atomic Energy Agency has said Iran was in compliance with the 2015 agreement, which allowed some enrichment. Recently, Iran and the IAEA said the country began exceeding limits imposed by the deal.

## People from wealthier backgrounds in UK more likely to be cricketers

PEOPLE FROM WEALTHIER backgrounds in the UK were much more likely to make it into professional cricket than those coming from less affluent families, according to a study.

The research found that 56% of Under 16 – Under 19 cricketers, and 45% of professional players, were White-British and attended independent schools, according to the study from Birmingham City University.

White-British cricketers who were privately educated are significantly over represented at both the professional and youth levels of the game, the study claimed.

Results also highlighted that a lack of access to wealth created barriers to participation and development in cricket, contributing to an ethnicity bias in the sport across Britain.

## Merkel suffers third bout of shaking

GERMAN CHANCELLOR ANGELA Merkel had her third spell of shaking in a month, putting persistent questions over her health back into focus.

Merkel, 64, was seen trembling briefly as she stood alongside Finnish Prime Minister Antti Rinne during a ceremony in Berlin on Wednesday, according to footage on German broadcaster NTV. Merkel later appeared as planned at a press conference with Rinne and didn't show any signs of trembling.

"I am feeling good," she told reporters, adding the issue wasn't anything affecting her leadership abilities. "I said recently that I am in a phase of working through what happened at the military honors ceremony with President Zelenskyy. It's obviously not fully completed, but there has been progress and I will have to live with it for a while," she said referring to the first trembling incident that occurred last month during a ceremony on a hot afternoon alongside the Ukrainian leader.

Following the first two bouts of shaking, Merkel navigated the Group of 20 summit in Japan and attended marathon negotiations in Brussels over European Union top jobs. "I am feeling very good, and there is no reason for concern," she said. The latest scare puts pressure on Merkel's office to provide fuller transparency about her health. Until now, the shaking episodes were attributed to dehydration and the subsequent psychological effects.

Questions over her well-being arise as Germany's economy is losing steam and relations within the governing coalition are strained.

## Saudi royals would face US visa restriction in new bill

SENATE REPUBLICANS SEEKING a way to punish Saudi Arabia over its human rights record without provoking a veto by President Donald Trump are trying a new strategy: denying visas for members of the kingdom's royal family.

Senate Foreign Relations chairman Jim Risch, an Idaho Republican, plans to unveil legislation on Wednesday that includes a measure to bar members of the royal family who work in the Saudi government from entering the US, according to a person familiar with the legislation. If signed into law, hundreds of people could face the restrictions.

"This legislation is an effort to move the US/Saudi relationship in a different direction and I am hopeful to have the support of my colleagues in doing so," Risch said in a statement. "We are all in agreement that we need to see a change in Saudi conduct going forward, and this bill would have a real impact in doing that."

The bill has at least one Democratic co-sponsor: Senator Jeanne Shaheen of New Hampshire, and the committee plans to vote on it this month, along with a bill from the panel's ranking Democrat, Bob Menendez, to bar some arms sales to Saudi Arabia and impose sanctions over the killing of the columnist Jamal Khashoggi.

## Uber drivers say London mayor's new levy is discriminatory

LONDON MAYOR SADIQ Khan's decision to charge Uber drivers to operate in the city centre amounts to racial discrimination and puts some out of business, lawyers for the drivers said Wednesday in court, in the latest stage of a long-running battle between those working for the ride-hailing firm and traditional cabbies.

A union representing Uber drivers is suing the city's mayor, saying it isn't fair that they must pay a daily charge of £11.50 (\$14.34) when tradi-

tional black-cab drivers don't have to. While 94% of Uber drivers come from minority backgrounds, 88% of black-cab drivers are white, the union said, meaning the levy 'impacts disproportionately' on minorities.

Uber drivers tend to be 'individuals working long hours in order to make ends meet and provide for their families in difficult circumstances', union lawyer Ben Collins said in court Wednesday. They include 'some of those least able to withstand a reduction in their income', he said.

The mayor said in court filings that the levy is an 'im-

portant means of reducing road congestion and traffic' in central London. "We will robustly defend our position," a Transport for London spokesman said.

Drivers 'are driven out of business or required to work hours which impact on their family, well-being and potentially health', because of the levy, which was extended to Uber drivers in April, the Independent Workers Union of Great Britain said in its court filings. The charge has a 'disproportionate impact on the income of part-time female drivers', it said.
